#### **NEW BUSINESS**

1.) Discuss and receive comments on the 2017 CCR water quality report

Derek Malone discussed the report. No issues with quality of drinking water, all naturally occurring minerals are within the allowable amount determined by TCEQ. No questions or responses from customers. No motion needed on this item.

2.) Approval of corrections to the zoning ordinance pertaining to the maximum density for Residential 8 from 3.25 to 1, Rural Residential from .75 to one and Agricultural from no limit to one.

Zach Cox explained to the council these are items that were not addressed at the time of adopting the zoning ordinance and needed to be corrected to one dwelling unit per lot to be less confusing for residents.

Motion by Sally Grimes, second by Matt Hutsell to approve zoning corrections as presented. Motion carried 5/0

3.) Discuss and possibly approve Mayor Johnson to sign Financial Advisory Agreement with Government Capital to possibility acquire Certificates of Obligation for street repairs and upgrades.

Certificate of Obligations will be for \$ 1,000,000.00 (one million dollars) for street improvements and upgrades. Current bonds will be paid in full September 2019. City is in good financial standing and needs to move forward with procuring the CO's. Funds will be received in October 2018 for the new fiscal year.

Motion by Chip Foster, second by Craig Davis authorizing Mayor Johnson to sign agreement and move forward with procuring the Certificates of Obligation.
